

ACCMA: Laws and Ethics for Public Management December 13-14, 2018

- **Location:** The Central Alabama Electric Cooperative, 103 Jesse Samuel Hunt Boulevard in Prattville, Alabama. For directions, search your browser or GPS, or refer to the website at www.accma-online.org.
- **Course Description:** This course explores ethics and basic legal responsibilities associated with managing in the public sector. Maintaining a balance between how the government administrator works and what the expectations are of the government agency for which they work is discussed in this course. This course will also address the ethical tensions that may arise in sustaining that balance. The Tenets of the ICMA Code of Ethics will be explored in this course.
